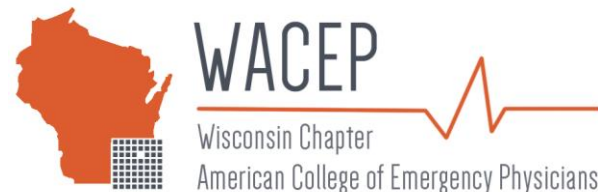

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2018 Annual Meeting Minutes

Thursday, March 15, 2018, The Edgewater, Madison

Call to Order: Dr. Maurer called the meeting to order at 12:15 pm, welcomed all attendees, and thanked them for participating in the 2018 Symposium. She thanked all vendors for supporting the organization.

PAC Update: Dr. Maurer encouraged attendees to participate in the organization's PAC and shared the importance of political action committees to the political process. She reported on the headway WACEP is making with elected officials and other decision makers in Madison on the issues important to emergency physicians in Wisconsin.

Annual WACEP Update: Dr. Maurer reported that membership in the Wisconsin Chapter is growing, and the organization's financial position is strong. She provided highlights of the many activities being worked on by the Board of Directors and other active members, and the impact our efforts are making on the advocacy front.
